Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

This project includes 21,700 feet of Class 2 bike lanes/routes, 100 feet of Class 4 bike lanes/routes, 6 green pavement enhancements, 4 resurface and restripe bike lanes, 14,927 feet of new sidewalk, 63 new curb ramps, 97 reconstructed ramps to standard, 46 ped-heads, 26 shorten crossings, 4 flashing beacons, 2 crossing-surface improvements, and 4 flush medians for traffic calming.

Equipment staging will be provided within the temporary construction easement areas. No specific disposal or borrow sites have been identified. These facilities will be established in accordance with the Standard Specifications. Construction activities will include demo of existing asphalt, sidewalk, and curb within project limits, placement of aggregate base and pavement, piping existing irrigation ditch underground, extension of sewer and stormwater lines through intersection, and street light installation. Roadway detours and/or lane closures may be used to control traffic during construction.
