Project Location (Mono County): The TD1552549 Old Mammoth Road Deteriorated Pole Replacement Project (project) is located within Mammoth Creek on private land approximately 350 feet north of Old Mammoth Road, in the city of Mammoth Lakes, Mono County, State of California; Latitude 37.629277, Longitude -118.990753.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. EPIMS-MOO-34751-R6, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Southern California Edison.

The project is limited to removing and replacing one deteriorated wood distribution pole (Pole 2055471E) with a new wood pole.

Project activities described above are anticipated to temporarily impact 0.035 acre of resources subject to Fish and Game Code Section 1602.
