Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project: The Delft Colony Wastewater Treatment Facility (WWTF) currently operates under Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB), Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR) Order No. 88-097. A Report of Waste Discharge (ROWD) will be prepared for the existing WWTF in order to apply for enrollment under the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) Order WQ 2014-0153-DWQ, General Waste Discharge Requirements for Small Domestic Wastewater Systems (General Order). The facility will continue to operate at the original designed capacity with no changes to operations.
