Project Location: The Project is located in Snyder Creek, at 7114 Hites Cove Road, approximately six miles east of Highway 140, north of the intersection of Hites Cove Road and Snyder Creek Road, Mariposa County, State of California; Assessor's Parcel Number 009-080-0020; Latitude 37.586847, Longitude -119.85167.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-MAR-42391-R4, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the Applicant, Marion Beck.

The Project includes activities related to building a footbridge over Snyder Creek and constructing a retaining wall to protect the bank from further erosion.
