Project Title: BVFS INC (Project)

Project Location: The Project is located at 761 Barker Valley Road, Hayfork, CA 96041 in Trinity County.

County: Trinity County

Project Description: The Department of Cannabis Control, pursuant to authority granted under Business and Profession Code, Division 10, Chapter 2, Section 26012, approved a Small Mixed-Light Tier 1 commercial cannabis license.

Project Activities: The full activity description can be found in the Notice of Determination produced by Trinity County. The project includes the cultivation of up to 10,000 square feet of small mixed-light cannabis. No associate changes to the cultivation site or associate activities are proposed. No additional grading or clearing operations are anticipated to be required. The project does not propose to expand the designated area. There are currently two (2) 30'x100' and one (1) 30'x130' permitted greenhouses for mature cultivation. Power for the Project site is provided through the Trinity Public Utility District grid. Water for the project would be provided from an existing groundwater well and an onsite septic system would serve the Project's domestic wastewater needs.

Reasons Why Project is Exempt: The Department of Cannabis Control has determined that the project is consistent with the local jurisdiction community plan and/or zoning designations. CEQA mandates that the project is consistent with the development density established by existing zoning, community plan, or general plan policies for which an EIR was certified and shall not require additional environmental review, except as might be necessary to examine whether there are project-specific significant effects which are peculiar to the project or its site. The project activity fits within the parameters included in CEQA Guidelines Section 15183 and the activity does not require additional CEQA analysis.
