Project Title: Caribou Road Debris Slide Damage Repair (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. PLU-52242-R2)

Project Location: The project is located at Caribou Road on the North Fork Feather River, in the County of Plumas, State of California; Latitude 40.062518° North, Longitude 121.192372° West.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number PLU-52242 -R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Pacific Gas and Electric Company.

The project consists of repairs and improvements to Caribou Road below Belden Reservoir in an area adjacent to the North Fork Feather River that was damaged during a debris slide into the river and subsequent flooding.

Person or Public Agency Carrying out Project: Pacific Gas and Electric Company

Exempt Status:

Categorical Exemption. Type – Class (1, 2, and 4); California Code of Regulations, title 14, sections (15301, 15302, and 15304)

Reasons why project is exempt: **Class 1** because this project involves repairs to an existing roadway. **Class 2** because some damaged aspects of the roadway infrastructure are being replaced. **Class 4** because the project will result in only minor alterations to the land and water where no removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees is involved.
