Project Title: St. Francis Revetment Emergency Replacement Project (Notification of Lake or Streambed Alteration, No. EPIMS-MON-52756-R4)

Project Location: The Project is located on State Route 1 in Big Sur at highway post mile 47.8, in the County of Monterey, California.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-MON-52756-R4, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the California Department of Transportation.

The Project would consist of reconstructing a rock slope protection revetment to alleviate the immediate emergency and potential loss of State Route 1.


Person or Public Agency Carrying Out Project: California Department of Transportation

Exempt Status:

- Statutory Exemption. (PRC 21080(b)); 14 CCR 15260 et seq.
- Categorical Exemption.

Reasons why project is exempt: In Monterey County on SR 1 in Big Sur at PM 47.8, a log jam that accumulated during previous heavy rainstorms altered the course of the Big Sur River and directed heavy flow towards the revetment causing loss of material in front of the revetment and subsequent failure of the revetment. Initiation of an emergency project was recommended to address failure of the revetment and an adjoining timber crib wall to protect the Highway 1 embankment.
