

**RESOLUTION
OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF RECLAMATION DISTRICT No. 2107**

Whereas said work may be funded through landowner assessments and/or the Department of Water Resources' Flood Maintenance Assistance Program (FMAP) program.

Whereas a project involving only feasibility or planning studies for possible future actions which the agency, board, or commission has not approved, adopted, or funded does not require the preparation of an EIR or negative declaration but does require consideration of environmental factors.

RESOLVED that the work included in Reclamation District No. 2107's ("District") 2024-2025 routine maintenance consists of the maintenance and/or repair of existing levee improvements which involves negligible or no expansion of said improvements' existing uses and, hence, falls within the categorical exemption to the California Environmental Quality Act set forth in California Code of Regulations, title 14, section 15301;


RESOLVED that in 2024 and 2025 the District plans to prepare a Letter of Intent and Systemwide Improvement Framework for PL 84-99 USACE coverage and that this type of work meets Statutory Exemption: 15262. Feasibility and Planning Studies.

RESOLVED that the District's Engineer is authorized to prepare and file with the County of San Joaquin the appropriate Notice of Exemption on behalf of the District.
