**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:** Project will utilize CAL FIRE resources for treatment to reduce fuels within Robert Louis Stevenson State Park. Fuels will be eliminated or greatly reduced within a 500-foot radius of the South Repeater Site infrastructure using mechanical and manual treatments.
