Air Quality impacts related to demolition of a structure that may contain asbestos may occur. Notification to the Mendocino County Air Quality Management District is required prior to construction as mitigation.

Biological Resources impacts related to temporary disturbance of a sensitive natural community and potential impacts to listed species may occur. Mitigation measures include implementation of Best Management Practices, transplantation of individual plants, construction area flagging and/or fencing, biological monitoring, avoidance of operations during nesting bird season, Norther spotted owl breeding season, and bat pupping season, construction during daylight hours, incremental demolition, pre-construction bat surveys and bat mitigation plan, pre-construction amphibian survey, and targeted removal of invasive species.

Tribal Cultural Resource impacts related to the potential unanticipated discovery of resources not already identified by archaeological surveys and historical resource evaluations may occur. Mitigation measures include tribal monitoring during trenching activities and avoidance of certain areas in coordination with the tribal monitor.
