Project Title: Amendment #13 to Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2022-0001-R2, (SPI Caldor Fire Emergency Salvage Projects)

Project Location: The project is located on a tributary to Alder Creek in Screech Owl Canyon in El Dorado County; Latitude 38.7466, Longitude -120.3758; Township 10N, Range 14E, Section 1 of the Leek Spring Hill U.S. Geological Survey Quad Map, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Amendment #13 to Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2022-0001-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Sierra Pacific Industries.
