The new windows would be in-kind to those existing, fit within the existing window spaces, and would not require widening or shrinking the existing window opening. The new windows would have the same style (including the same number of panes, window casing, moldings, and sills), materials, dimension, and texture as the existing windows to ensure the design and material are similar. Window details (such as hardware on the interior and dentils accenting the sides of each top sash) would be re-created to match the existing. Installation of the windows would commence in August 2024, and occur only when students are not in the rooms.
