Project Title: Pleasanton Ridge Regional Park Access Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0168-R3)

Project Location (include county): The project is located within the Pleasanton Ridge Regional Park, located within Alameda County, California. The northern extent of the Project site is located at approximately 37.691144°N, 121.952434°W, and the southern extent is located at approximately 37.594313°N, 121.895988°W.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2020-0168-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Toby Perry / East Bay Regional Park District.

This proposed project involves construction of a northern and southern staging area (Garms Staging Area and Tyler Ranch Staging Area), an access road connecting the Garms Staging Area to an existing road, and 15 stream crossings and two free-span bridges that will occur along the span of approximately 8.7 miles of new trails to be constructed.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as the Lead Agency / a Responsible Agency approved the above described project on August 17, 2021, has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. A mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to Public Resources Code section 21081, subdivision (a).
