State Parks has prepared a proposed draft Road and Trail Management Plan (RTMP) for the Prairie City State Vehicle Recreation Area (Prairie City SVRA). The RTMP provides a detailed management direction for the off-highway vehicle (OHV) route systems in nine management areas in Prairie City SVRA, guiding future development, operation, and maintenance. Development under the RTMP would design, construct, and maintain sustainable routes, trails, and related facilities for OHV use consistent with guidelines and regulations. Nonmotorized mountain biking and hiking trails are also proposed. Recommendations are provided to increase visitor safety and enjoyment, while protecting natural and cultural resources. The plan also includes recommendations to maintain the park's route and trail system, including new OHV and nonmotorized opportunities.


