# RIVER ROAD EMBANKMENT EROSION REPAIR

## Project Description

### **Project Location:**

**River Road:** 9,320 feet south of Shelton Road to Shelton Road. **See attached Vicinity Map.**

### **Project Justification:**

In January 2024, adjacent property owners along River Road observed significant erosion of the embankment and contacted San Joaquin County. This erosion poses potential risks to the structural integrity of the road, threatens nearby properties with potential flooding and land loss, and could lead to increased maintenance costs if not addressed promptly.

### **Scope of Work:**

The project will consist of:

1. Removing loose and/or unstable soil from eroded areas throughout the project location.
2. Backfilling, shaping, and compacting class II aggregate base or approved equal in the eroded areas.

### **Environmental Setting:**

In this portion of the San Joaquin County, land usage is primarily **rural with single family homes**.

**There are many large trees adjacent to the project area.** Nesting and migratory birds, protected by the Migratory Bird Treaty Act, may nest within these trees. Furthermore, the Swainson's Hawk, a raptor species of concern within the State of California and listed as threatened may nest adjacent to or within the project area. A pre-construction survey for nesting Swainson's Hawks and other migratory birds is recommended if construction is scheduled to occur from February 15<sup>th</sup> to September 1<sup>st</sup>.

### **Beneficiaries:**

By undertaking a project to stabilize and repair the embankment, the County can protect local infrastructure, ensure the safety of residents, and prevent more costly interventions in the future. Additionally, addressing the erosion aligns with the County's commitment to maintaining public safety and environmental sustainability.
