Project Title: Corral Hollow Creek Sediment Removal (Notification of Lake or Streambed Alteration, No. EPIMS-SJN-41344-R3)

Project Location (San Joaquin County): The project is located at Corral Hollow Creek, in the County of San Joaquin, State of California; Latitude 37.674107, Longitude -121.445162. The downstream culvert is located at Latitude 37.676098, Longitude -121.440616.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. EPIMS-SJN-41344-R3, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to California Department of Water Resources.

The project is limited to road re-establishment, re-establishment or maintenance of staging areas, repair of earthen ramps, construction of three (3) additional earthen ramps, sediment removal, rock slope protection (RSP) replenishment, and culvert debris removal. **Public Agency Approving Project: CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND WILDLIFE**
