Project Title: Felton Landslide Repair Along San Lorenzo River Project (Notification of Lake or Streambed Alteration, No. EPIMS-SCR-40733-R3)

Project Location (Santa Cruz): The Project is located at 7578 Highway 9, Felton, in the County of Santa Cruz, State of California; Latitude 37.06812, Longitude -122.08194; Assessor's Parcel Number 071-041-02.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. EPIMS-SCR-40733-R3, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Nicholas Adam.

In 2022 and 2023, heavy storms caused a landslide adjacent to the San Lorenzo River at 7578 Highway 9 in Felton, California. The Project is limited to the installation of a soldier pile retaining wall to repair a bank slip out. The retaining wall will be approximately 71 feet long by 7- to 9- feet high. The wall will span from the southernmost edge of the landslide affected area to the hillside located at the northern property line.


