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**NOTICE OF EXEMPTION**

**Title:** Authorization to Remove and Dispose of Abandoned Vessels – W27250

**Location:** Sovereign land in White Slough, adjacent to King Island, San Joaquin County.

**Description:** Authorize the Executive Officer, or her designee, on or after September 30, 2024, to direct one or more of the Commission's on-call abandoned vessel services contractors to remove and dispose of the vessel taken by the Commission and all of its contents.

**Exempt Status:**

Categorical Exemptions:

CLASS 4, MINOR ALTERATIONS TO LAND (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 2, § 2905, subd.(d)(3))

CLASS 30, MINOR ACTIONS TO PREVENT, MINIMIZE, STABILIZE, MITIGATE OR ELIMINATE THE RELEASE OR THREAT OF RELEASE OF HAZARDOUS WASTE OR HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 15330)

**Reasons for exemptions:**

Authorization to remove and dispose of abandoned vessels will only cause a minor physical change in the environment and will not change existing activities in the area. There is no reasonable possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment due to unusual circumstances. Therefore, the project will not have a significant effect on the environment and the above categorical exemptions apply.
