Project Title: TD1586878 Road 236 Anchor Replacement Project (Notification of Lake or Streambed Alteration No. EPIMS-TUL-49110-R4)

Project Location (Tulare County): The Project will occur at one location within an unnamed stream approximately 0.2 mile northwest of the intersection of Goodale Lane and Avenue 324, within the community of Lemon Cove, Tulare County, State of California; Assessor's Parcel Number 133-220-041; Township 18 South, Range 27 East, and Section 10; Latitude 36.378020° North and Longitude -119.041412° West.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-TUL-49110-R4, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the applicant, Southern California Edison Company.

The Project includes activities related to the removal and replacement of one metal rod and plate anchor, 436200EA2, associated with utility Pole 436200E. The rod and plate anchor will be replaced with a similar rod and plate anchor in the same location. The location will be accessed from Goodale Lane via an existing driveway with overland truck travel for approximately 375 feet, from the end of the driveway to the anchor location.


