The proposed Neighborhood Park would include recreational amenities such as a playfield, multipurpose courts, stage, tot lot, playground, picnic areas, interactive water feature, pedestrian trail, drinking fountains, and a 26-foot diagonal width mobile TV screen with an associated sound system. The project would serve community needs and provide opportunities for increased physical activity and social interaction.
