Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

The project would involve a mix of repair methods to address identified wastewater conveyance pipeline defects, including trenchless cured in place pipe relining, open-cut trench pipe replacement, open-cut point repairs, and manhole replacement. The project would involve repair or replacement of approximately 11,030 linear feet of pipeline and replacement of 31 manholes. The purpose of the proposed project is to repair or replace aging wastewater infrastructure, which is exceeding its design life of 50 years and experiencing defects associated with broken/fractured pipes, root intrusions, and offset joints. Repairs and replacements would improve the structural integrity of the wastewater system, which serves 231 residential and 40 commercial/industrial wastewater connections.

Reasons why project is exempt:

Class 1 projects consist of operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use. The project would involve repair or replacement of existing wastewater conveyance infrastructure. The project would not expand the use or increase the capacity of the existing wastewater system. Therefore, the Class 1 exemption is applicable. Class 2 projects consist of replacement or reconstruction of existing structures and facilities where the new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the structure replaced. The project would involve repair or replacement of existing wastewater conveyance infrastructure. The project would not expand the use of the existing wastewater system, and the repaired or replaced pipelines would be generally located in the same location as existing infrastructure and would have the same purpose and capacity as the existing system. Therefore, the Class 2 exemption is applicable.
