Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

150 ft of the west shoulder of Rosita Rd failed due to winter storms, causing half the roadway to sink substantially. This caused major cracking in the asphalt and left the road susceptible to erosion and further damage from future storms. The project consists of emergency repair of the road to allow continued use of the road and prevent traffic/road hazards.
