Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The District converted the existing school at 8425 Palm Street, Lemon Grove, California, into a District Office and developed a new campus for the Early Childhood Education Center (ECEC) on the western portion of the site. Three District departments currently operate onsite; upon the Governing Board's approval, the remaining District departments would be relocated to the project site. The special education program would have 75 students and 70 staff and teachers, and the ECEC would accommodate 400 students and 50 staff.
