Project Title: Section 31 Emergency

Project Location: The project is located in Siskiyou County CA as follows: Southeast ¼ Section 31, T37N, R09W, USGS 7.5" map quadrangle Caribou Lake MDBM. CalWater planning watershed is Kidd Creek (1105.240104).

Project Description: As part of approved Emergency timber harvest project # 2-24EM-00041-SIS, the described maintenance action is limited to replacement of one (1) permanent Class II CMP metal pipe at an existing crossing. The current CMP pipe is undersized and failing. A new larger 24" diameter by 30 ft. long CMP metal culvert pipe will be installed at the same location and will meet 100 flood passage capabilities.


