**SUBJECT: Filing of Notice of Determination pursuant to Public Resources Code section 21108**

Project Title: Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0231-R2 (Oui Oui Timber Harvesting Plan 4-18-00155-ELD, Sierra Pacific Industries)

Project Location: The projects are located within the boundaries of a timber harvesting plan in El Dorado County, within CALWATER watersheds Stoney Creek, Rocky Basin Creek, Lower and Upper South Forks Rubicon River and connecting tributaries; Township 13N, Range 14E, Sections 9, 13, 14, 16, 17, 21, 22, 23, 26, 27, 28, 29, 34, 35; and Township 12N, Range 14E, Section 2 of U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) Quad Maps Robbs Peak and Loon Lake, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Project: This action will extend the term of the Agreement from October 8, 2024 to September 15, 2026. All other conditions in the original Agreement remain in effect.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
