Project Title: TD1748177 Tenaja Road Deteriorated Pole Replacement Project (Notification of Lake or Streambed Alteration, No. EPIMS-RIV-30094-R6)

Project Location (Riverside County): The Tenaja Road Deteriorated Pole Replacement project (project) is located near the intersection of Cleveland Forest Road and Tenaja Road within an unnamed stream that is tributary to San Mateo Creek, in the County of Riverside, State of California; Latitude 33.505534, Longitude -117.353709.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has amended Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. EPIMS-RIV-30094-R6, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Southern California Edison.

The amended project involves the removal and replacement of Pole 4357930E.

Amended project activities described above will not create additional impacts beyond the 0.021 acre of temporary impacts to streambed resources identified in the original agreement.
