The applicant is requesting approval of a Conditional Use Permit (CUP) to permit a meditation facility. The facility is a rebuild of a previous burned down barn of the same size, thirty (30) feet by seventy (70) feet. The facility is proposed to run by the landowners, and a proposed occupancy of less than 50 people. The proposal describes two small offices for administrative purposes, two ADA compliant bathrooms, no seating in the meditation area, and no overnight lodging. A parking lot with 17 spaces to support the use is included in the proposal.
