The addition of these new limited temporary structures and small equipment will not have a significant effect on the environment. Therefore, this project falls under categorical exemption Section 15303 of the CEQA Guidelines.

Therefore, none of the exceptions to categorical exemptions listed in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 apply to this project, and this project will not have a significant effect on the environment.
