The proposed construction of the new weights room building (Building H) is exempt from CEQA under Class 14, *Minor Additions to Schools* (Section 15314). The new weight room building will be located within the school campus and will include the addition of two new classrooms; however, the proposed project will not increase student capacity. The new weight room will be located within the existing school campus and will improve the

athletic facilities for student athletes. The new building will be located within the same campus and will not increase the school classrooms by more than ten; therefore, the project is exempt from CEQA under Section 15314.

The proposed project was also reviewed for possible exceptions under Section 15300.2 and found that the exceptions do not apply
