Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The County of San Diego Department of General Services (DGS) is proposing to construct a new approximately 8,500 square foot fire station on an approximately 2.77-acre site (portion of APN 660-150-18-00) in the unincorporated community of Jacumba. The proposed fire station would replace the existing Jacumba fire station located at 1255 Jacumba Street, Jacumba, CA 91934 (APN 660-053-01). The new fire station would be identified by the same station number and would have the same service area as the existing Jacumba Fire Station (i.e., Fire Station No. 43).

Identify the project's significant or potentially significant effects and briefly describe any proposed mitigation measures that would reduce or avoid that effect.

The proposed project has the potential for significant effects in relation to Biological, Cultural and Tribal Cultural Resources which will be reduced to a level of less than significant with Mitigation. Biological Mitigation measures include off-site mitigation for impacts to non-native grassland, burrowing owl pre-construction surveys, biological monitoring during all vegetation clearing/grubbing/rough grading, and nesting bird avoidance measures. Cultural and Tribal Cultural mitigation measures include implementing archaeological and native american monitoring.
