Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The Town proposes to redevelop the project site with sixteen pickleball courts (two are proposed at a future date), two basketball courts, tables and seating areas and bleachers with shade structures, and a restroom building. The proposed project also includes expanding the parking lot, demolishing and reconstructing the skate park, and installing new fencing and landscaping throughout the project site. No subterranean levels are proposed. Construction of the proposed project would occur over three phases.
