Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. EPIMS-SMO-38282-R3, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Brian Yee.

The Project is limited to the removal of a small concrete obstruction in Borel Creek using a jackhammer and native plant restoration on surrounding banks.


