Project Title: Timber Harvest Plan "Franchini" 1-23-00018 SON (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-SON-40535-R3)

Project Location (include county): The project is located at unnamed tributaries to, and including, Franchini Creek in the County of Sonoma, State of California; Section 1, Township 10N, Range 1W, Section 30, Township 11N, Range 13W, and Sections 25, 26, 36, Township 11N, Range 14W; U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) Maps McGuire Ridge, Gube Mountain, Annapolis, and Stewarts Point, Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-SON-40535-R3 pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Lily Engle.

The project is limited to water drafting from Franchini Creek, and installing two culverts at a Class II watercourse, four culverts at a Class III watercourse, five rocked fords at a Class III watercourse, and six temporary dips at a Class III watercourse.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on 8/29/2024 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
