**Project Title:** TD2036662 Globe Drive Deteriorated Pole and Anchor Replacement Project (Notification of Lake or Streambed Alteration No. EPIMS-TUL-51376-R4)

**Project Location (Tulare County):** The Project will occur at four locations within an unnamed tributary to Tule River, within approximately 550 feet west and 300 feet east of the intersection of Tule Oak Drive and Globe Drive, within the community of Springville, Tulare County, State of California; Assessor's Parcel Number 284-620-039:

- Pole 4506045E – Latitude 36.086222, Longitude -118.830291
- Pole X16277E – Latitude 36.086371, Longitude -118.829399
- Pole 4506044E – Latitude 36.086508, Longitude -118.828488

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-TUL-51376-R4, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the applicant, Southern California Edison Company.

The Project includes activities related to the removal and replacement of utility poles and installation of pole anchors and grounding rods for four utility poles. All poles will be accessed from the adjacent Globe Drive.


**Person or Public Agency Carrying Out Project:** Southern California Edison Company
