Description of nature, purpose, and beneficiaries of Project:	On April 28, 2021, the Joint Powers Commission authorized the March Inland Port Airport Authority’s (MIPAA) to submit an application to the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) for the preparation of an Airport Master Plan. The master plan would allow MIPAA to establish a 20-year plan for the buildout of the airport. This Master Plan and associated airport layout plan was approved by the Joint Powers Commission on September 11, 2024 for submittal to and review by the FAA.
