Reasons why project is exempt:

Section 21080.20 (as amended by SB 922) exempts active transportation plans from review under CEQA. The proposed Sacramento Avenue Complete Street Plan qualifies for a Statutory Exemption under SB 922 as an active transportation plan because it is a plan developed by a local jurisdiction (City of West Sacramento) that promotes and encourages people to choose walking, bicycling, or rolling through the creation of safe, comfortable, connected, and accessible walking, bicycling, or rolling networks, and encourages alternatives to single-occupancy vehicle trips. While the adoption of the Sacramento Avenue Complete Street Plan is exempt from CEQA, specific projects identified within the Plan remains subject to CEQA
