Good afternoon.

The California Highway Patrol's Marin Area has reviewed the Notice of Preparation of a Draft Environmental Impact Report and Environmental Assessment for the US-101/I-580 Multi-Modal and Local Access Improvement Project, submitted by Caltrans District 4 (SCH # 2024100157). The three build alternatives proposed will likely present transportation issues and have an effect on vehicular traffic primarily due to the anticipated construction related lane closures and detours. There is nothing in the project description that stands out though as impacting public safety, congestion, or traffic safety beyond what is expected for such a large scale project that will result in better connectivity and improve congestion for the long term. We anticipate there will be an impact to CHP operations with increased response times because of any lane closures and detours.

As is the case with any State Highway related construction project, CHP-Marine requests all anticipated project related transportation issues be communicated to our office well in advance. The advanced notification will allow us to adjust operations accordingly and maintain our ability to provide the highest level of safety, service, and security.
