Project Title: CFIA New Buoy Installation (Lake Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. PLA-51532-R2)

Project Location: The project is located at Lake Tahoe, in the County of Placer, State of California; 4370 North Lake Boulevard, Carnelian Bay, CA 96140.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number PLA-51532-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Cedar Flat Improvement Association.

The project consists of the placement of fifteen (15) new mooring buoys in Lake Tahoe, as part of a buoy field expansion, by means of a barge mounted crane which will lower the anchor blocks, with chains and buoys attached, to the lakebed.
