Project Title: Tebon Stream Crossing Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-HUM-53598-R1C)

Project Location: The Project is located within the Big Lagoon watershed, approximately 9 ¾ miles north of the city of Trinidad, County of Humboldt, State of California. The Project is located in Section 6, T9N, R1E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Rodgers Peak U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor’s Parcel Number 518-012-017; latitude 41.1995 N and longitude 124.1041 W at the site of the crossing.

Project Description: The Project is limited to one encroachment to upgrade an existing stream crossing located on a Pacific Gas & Electric access road. Work for this encroachment will include excavation and removal of the existing crossing fill, installation of two 4-inch conduits to carry water and power utility lines, installation of a minimum 24-inch diameter culvert, backfilling and compaction of fill, rock armoring the inlet and outlet, hydrologically disconnecting the road, and rocking the road approaches.

The project will not result in impacts that are significant when viewed in connection with the effects of past projects, the effects of other current projects, and the effects of probable future projects.
