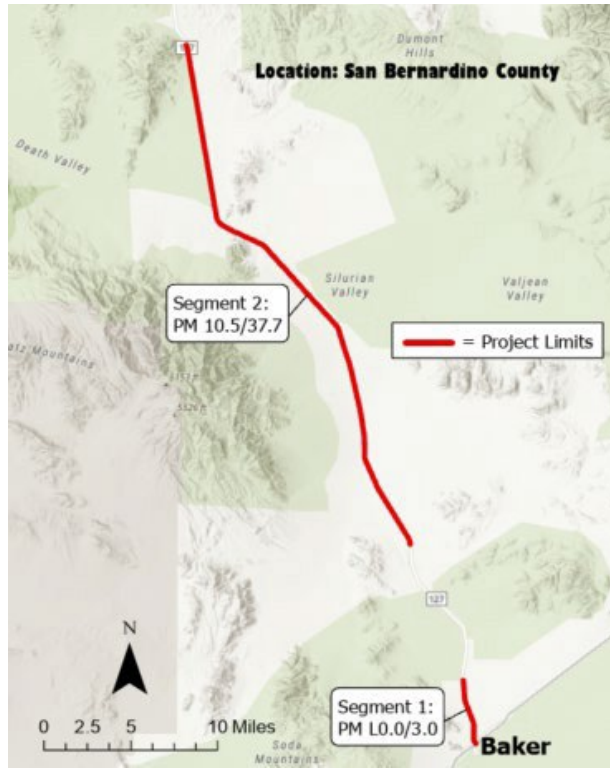

Notice of Availability of an Environmental Assessment Announcement of Opportunity for Public Hearing SBD-127 Pavement Rehabilitation Near Baker, CA



<p>WHAT'S BEING PLANNED?</p>	<p>The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes multi-objective priorities for overall transportation needs including Capital Preventative Maintenance (CAPM), construction of pedestrian sidewalks and bike lanes, upgrading curb ramps, replacement of guardrail at Amargosa River Bridge, and upgrading/replacing signage. Work will occur within Baker to 1.42 miles north of Airfield Road and from 2.3 miles north of Silver Lake Road to 3.8 miles south of the San Bernardino/Inyo County Line.</p>
<p>WHY THIS NOTICE?</p>	<p>Caltrans has studied the effects this project may have on the environment. The studies show the project will not significantly affect the quality of the environment. The report that explains why is called an Environmental Assessment. This notice is to tell you of the preparation of the Environmental Assessment and of its availability for you to read and to offer the opportunity for a public hearing.</p>
