DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: In November 2018, the Woolsey Fire resulted in the destruction of facilities at Leo Carrillo State Park including the staircase accessing the South Beach area from Pacific Coast Highway (PCH). A replacement staircase would be constructed approximately 200 feet WSW of the original location in order to avoid cultural artifacts which surround the original staircase location while still providing visitor access.
