NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

Notice is hereby given that the Williams Fire Protection Authority has prepared an Initial Study (IS) of environmental effects and intends to adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) for the Williams Fire Station project. The Williams Fire Protection Authority is the Lead Agency for this project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).

The project proposes the construction of a fire station on a one-acre parcel in eastern Williams. The total footprint of the station would be approximately 11,167 square feet consisting of the station building and ambulatory area supporting emergency medical services.

The IS/MND analyzes the potential environmental effects of the project in accordance with CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines. Based on this analysis, the IS/MND finds that the project will not involve any significant environmental effects, provided that the mitigation measures described in the IS/MND are implemented. The City has agreed to the mitigation measures and these measures will be adopted by the Williams Fire Protection Authority with the IS/MND. There are no sites identified under Section 65962.5 of the Government Code located on or near the project site.
