Notice of Intent to Prepare an Environmental Impact Report

As lead agency under the California Environmental Quality Act, the Port of Stockton is providing this Notice of Intent to prepare an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) assessing the potential environmental effects associated with the following project:

Nevada Cement Company LLC Stockton Terminal Modernization Project

The proposed project is located at 205 Port Road 1 in the East Complex of the Port of Stockton in Stockton, California.

The proposed project includes a lease modification and improvements to an existing cementitious materials receiving and distribution marine terminal at the Port of Stockton to improve and expand operational efficiency.
