PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Amigos de Los Rios will implement a green schoolyard project at six school sites. Project activities will include removing 12,800 square feet of asphalt, planting 480 trees, planting 4,315 shrubs, creating 22 outdoor classrooms, and creating 7 nature based play areas.

REASONS PROJECT IS EXEMPT
