Project Title: D2 D3 Pipeline Inspection and Repair Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement, No. EPIMS-VEN-48951-R5).

Project Location (Ventura County): The Project is located within the Ellsworth Barranca, within the City of Santa Paula in Ventura County, State of California; Latitude 34.29577N, Longitude: -119.13435W; Assessor's Parcel Numbers (APN) 090-0-180-020 and 090-0-172-030.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-VEN-48951-R5, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Vallerie Muller.

The Project is limited to the excavation, inspection, and minor repair of the D2 Pipeline within the Ellsworth Barranca. Repairs will be in-kind. A sandbag cofferdam will be used to isolate the work site, and the channel will be recontoured to pre-disturbed conditions once the work is completed. The Project scope previously included the D3 site within the Todd Barranca but was removed.
