## Notice of Intent to Adopt Draft Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration for the SR-78 Julian Asset Management Project

### WHAT'S BEING PLANNED

In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) District 11 is circulating an Initial Study with Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) for public comment. Caltrans proposes to rehabilitate and enhance various assets on State Route 78 in eastern San Diego County, between post miles 37.2 and 60.0. Proposed improvements include pavement rehabilitation; culvert rehabilitation; Complete Streets and mobility elements, such as Americans with Disabilities Act curb ramps; and safety/roadside element improvements, including sign panels, guardrails, rumble strips, and dikes.
