**Project Title:** Kiaski Pile Replacement (Lake Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. LAK-53924-R2)

**Project Location:** The project is located at Clear Lake, in the County of Lake, State of California; Latitude 39.041158°, Longitude -122.751645° (WGS 84 datum, decimal degrees); 8563 Paradise Lagoon Drive, Lucerne, CA 95458; Assessor's Parcel Number [APN] 060-332-250-000.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number LAK-53924-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Paula Kiaski.

The project is limited to the removal and replacement of 4 damaged wooden piles under the existing boat lift. Four new 10-inch steel pile supports with headers will be installed to provide better support for the lift. The wooden piles will be cut flush with the lakebed and all other existing structures will remain in place.

**Exempt Status:**

Categorical Exemption. Type – Class 2 and 4; California Code of Regulations, title 14, sections 15302 and 15304

**Reasons why project is exempt:**

Class 2 because the project consists of the replacement of existing boat lift piles involving negligible expansion of capacity.

Class 4 because the project consists of a minor alteration to Clear Lake and does not involve the removal of healthy, mature, or scenic trees.
