**Project Title:** Murphys Park Pedestrian Bridge Repair (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. CAL-51198-R2)

**Project Location:** The project is located at Angels Creek, in the County of Calaveras, State of California; Latitude 38.136716, Longitude -120.463583 (WGS 84 datum, decimal degrees); Assessor's Parcel Number 066-001-022.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number CAL-51198-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Calaveras County, as represented by Jacob Lile.

The project is limited to the repair and reinforcement of existing rock slope protection on each side of a pedestrian bridge within Murphys Community Park.

**Reasons why project is exempt:** The project is exempt under section 15301 because it involves minor alteration of existing public or private structures. The project is exempt under section 15302 because it involves the replacement or reconstruction of existing structures and facilities where the new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the structure replaced. The project is exempt under section 15304 because it involves minor alterations to land that does not involve the removal of healthy, mature, or scenic trees.
