Project Location/Address/City/County: The project is located at left bank levee at 7173 Garden Hwy, Sacramento 95837, in Sacramento County.

Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project: The project includes installation of a private boat dock with cover, gangway, and landing. The purpose of the dock is to moor a privately-owned boat and to provide recreational access to the river. The proposed dock and gangway will be manufactured off-site and delivered to the nearest boat ramp. Installation of the dock will require pile driving of three (3) 12" steel piles with a barge-mounted pile driver.

Reasons Why Project is Exempt:

The Board has determined the project is exempt from CEQA under the Class 3, New Construction of Small Structures categorical exemption (CEQA California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 15303), because the activity consists of construction and location of limited numbers of new, small facilities or structures; installation of small new equipment and facilities in small structures; and the conversion of existing small structures from one use to another where only minor modifications are made in the exterior of the structure. The project is also exempt from CEQA under the Class 4, Minor Alterations to Land categorical exemption (CEQA California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 15304), because the activity consists of minor public or private alterations in the condition of land, water, and/or vegetation which do not involve removal of mature, scenic trees except for forestry and agricultural purposes. Further, none of the exceptions to the exemption in CEQA California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 15300.2 apply.
