Reasons why project is exempt:

The project is categorically exempt from the requirements of the CEQA Guidelines per Section 15301 Class 1 (c), (d), (h), and (i), "Existing Facilities," because the project involves routine maintenance activities necessary to prevent the flooding of the Bayfront Canal and to maintain its water transport capacity, and structural and functioning integrity. Vegetation will be removed using equipment staged on the adjacent Cargill levee and the parking lot off of Rose Avenue. All vegetation and debris will be taken off-site for disposal and there will be no discharge into the canal or downstream waterbody. Heavy equipment will not enter the canal at any time. All appropriate stormwater management measures will be taken to minimize impacts to the canal and downstream waterbodies, and there is no reasonable possibility that the project will have a significant effect on the environment.
